The Beach House is now taking reservations for end of the year school pool parties. The Annenberg Community Beach House is a unique public facility located on Santa Monica State Beach. The Beach House not only offers a beautiful pool, but also a Splash Pad and Children's Play Area, Beach Volleyball Courts and Beach Soccer Fields, all of which can be made available for your group's end of the school year celebration.

To make a reservation for your group, complete the enclosed application and return it to the Beach House via email, fax or mail by **Friday, May 4th, 2012**. You will be contacted by **Tuesday, May 15th, 2012** to confirm your reservations. Please note that full payment is required in advance to secure your reservation. Refunds for cancellations will only be given with one week advance written notification.

Enclosed you will find a price list and the 2012 Beach House Pool & Beach Party Permit Application which will assist you in completing reservations for your group at the Beach House.

Because group sizes vary and the Beach House operates with a predetermined maximum capacity, groups smaller than 75 people may be paired with other groups of similar size on your requested date. When visiting the Beach House with your group, we ask that you assist us in ensuring the safety of all students by providing a 1:10 adult to youth ratio. The Beach House staff will make every effort to make sure that you have adequate space and opportunity to enjoy a great day at the Beach House.

Defense, Indemnity, and Hold Harmless Agreement

Applicant and organization hereby waive all claims against the City for damages to goods, waters, merchandise, or improvements in, upon or about the Annenberg Community Beach House facility; and for injuries to applicant organization's property or employees or any other persons in or about the facility from any cause arising at any time. Application and organization will hold the City exempt and harmless from any damages or injuries to any person or to the goods, wages, merchandise, facilities or other property or any person arising from the use of the facility by applicant an organization or other persons or from the failure of the City to keep the facility in good condition and repair when such damage or injury is caused in part or whole by the negligence or fault of, or omission of any duty with respect to the same by applicant or organization.

Applicant and organization expressly waive all rights under Section 1342 of the Civil Code of California as it now provides or may hereafter be amended. Section 1342 reads as follows: "A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor at the time of executing the release, which if know by him have materially affected his settlement with debtor." Applicant and organization accept the Annenberg Community Beach House facilities in their present condition, and are without representation or warranty by the City as to the condition of such, or as the use or occupancy which may be made thereof and the City shall not be responsible for latent defect or change in their condition, or for any damage occurring thereto, or because of the existence of any violation of any state, county, or municipal laws.

End of the School Year Pool and Beach Party Price List

Activity	Price
Pool Admission Adult (18+)	\$10 per person
Pool Admission Youth (1-17)	\$4 per person
Pool Admission Senior (60+)	\$5 per person
Beach Volleyball Courts	\$5 per court (90 minute reservation) (Beach volleyballs available on request)
Beach Soccer Fields	\$5 per field (90 minute reservation) (Soccer balls available on request)
Beach Canopy	\$20 per canopy (2 hour reservation) (12' x 12' canopy and two 5' plastic tables)
Please note that all vehicles parking at the Beach House are required to pay the usual parking fees of \$4 per hour or \$8 per day.	

Beach House Pool Rules

For the safety and enjoyment of all pool guests:

- Swimmers must shower before entering the water
- Swim suits or equivalent must be worn in the water for health & safety reasons
- **Children under age 12 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times**
- **Children under age 8 and under 4' in height must be accompanied by an adult in the water at all times**
- Children requiring diapers must wear a swim diaper in the water
- Pool deck furniture and umbrellas may not be moved
- No outside furniture or umbrellas may be set-up on the Pool Deck
- To provide a pleasurable experience for all guests chairs may not be reserved

The following are prohibited:

- Running, rough play, pushing or dunking of others
- Bikes, scooters, skateboards
- Glass containers
- Masks, fins or snorkels during recreational swim for safety reasons
- Toys in the water, unless distributed by Beach House staff for safety reasons
- Flotation devices (except Coast Guard approved lifejackets)

Guests must abide by the decision of Beach House staff regarding the interpretation of any rules governing the use of this facility. Any behavior or activity determined by the staff to be unsafe, hazardous, inappropriate, or a violation of the rules is prohibited.
